The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh presents its compliments to all Diplomatic Missions and Offices of the UN Agencies and International Organizations in Dhaka and has the honour to inform that, in view of the latest coronavirus related developments in Bangladesh, the Government of Bangladesh has taken the following decisions:

- With effect from 1200 hrs of 16 March 2020 until 31st March 2020, passengers originating from Europe, except for UK, will not be allowed to enter Bangladesh;
- All Bangladesh-bound flights, originating from countries that have suspended incoming flights from Bangladesh, will remain suspended;
- All on-arrival visas of Bangladesh will remain suspended for two weeks for incoming passengers of all countries;
- Those who will henceforth be arriving in Bangladesh from other coronavirus affected countries will be placed under self-quarantine for two weeks after their arrival. This will continue until further notice.
- Diplomatic passport holders with valid visas will be exempted from the restrictions mentioned in paragraph (a) above;
- Foreign nationals with valid visas staying in Bangladesh now will have the option of extension of their existing visas by 3 (three) months.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, avails itself of this opportunity to renew to all Diplomatic Missions and Offices of the UN Agencies and International Organizations in Dhaka, the assurances of its highest consideration.
